Side effects can last for hours




Cocaine is synthetically created in a lab

# The most commonly used drugs in India are cannabis, opium and heroin

Cannabis consumption is legal in Odisha

# 182,622 kg of ganja and 2,489 kg of hashish was seized in India in 2016

#### There are 10 suicides in India every day due to drug or alcohol abuse

# Mizoram is the highest consumer of tobacco in India

# Andhra Pradesh is the highest consumer of alcohol in India

# Alcohol kills one Indian every 96 minutes

# There are more than 10 lakh drug addicts in Punjab. The most common drug consumed is heroin (chitta)

The average Indian consumes 4.3 litres of alcohol per year. The average rural Indian consumes 11.4 litres of alcohol per year

While a 100 gm of weed in New Delhi costs about Rs. 1,000, in the drug fields of Manipur, 1 kg of high quality marijuana can be bought for Rs. 700

1687 kg of amphetamine-type stimulants (ATS) such as MDMA was seized in 2017. Most cases were in Gujarat and Andhra Pradesh

21,272 kg of ephedrine was seized across India in 2017. **Ephedrine** is a prescription stimulant used in cough syrups

# 28 Kgs of cocaine was seized in India in 2016, down from 44 kg in 2012

# 67% of the rural households in Punjab have one drug or alcohol addict

#### A survey of Delhi's street children aged 9-13 revealed

- Around 70,000 consume drugs in any form
- 20,000 consume tobacco
- Around 10,000 consume alcohol
- 7000 children consume inhalants
- 5600 children are using cannabis
- Around 800 are addictive to heroin
